

- **WHAT?** National Portfolio Day is a college fair of ART colleges!
- WHEN? Friday and Saturday, November 17th & 18th
- WHERE? Washington, D.C. at Washington University's Corcoran School of Art
- **WHO?** All DSA Visual Arts students & Art History interested in applying to art schools for college.

Any student interested in going on the trip must:

- (1) Be currently enrolled in an art class or art history class at DSA
- (2) Have at least 10-15 artworks approved (by teacher) to show school representatives, or be enrolled in an art history class.
- **WHY ?** Students show work directly to representatives from many of the country's major art schools and art programs to get specific feedback before applying to the school. Art History students will participate in chaperoned museum tours.
- **Cost? §190 per student** (If you/your family can pay more, that will help with support of students who may not be able to pay the full amount)
